

Obedience Course Outline

Obedience courses are offered in either 6 or 8 course packages. The course duration takes roughly 8 to 10 weeks. If additional time is needed there is no extra charge. Each class is 1 hour long. Unlimited help is available 24/7.

COMMANDS

DEFINITIONS

Heel:	Stay with me" Dog walks on your left side; shoulder is 6 inches away from your knee. Leash hanging loosely in a "J".
Left Turn:	Turning left as sharp as possible while the dog remains in the heel position.
Right Turn:	Turning right as sharp as possible while the dog remains in the heel position.
Sit:	Sitting straight up.
Stand:	Standing on all four legs straight.
Down:	Lying down straight with hind legs square to the ground.
Stay:	Staying in all 3 commands, sit-down-stand regardless of any distractions.
Come:	Coming when called and sitting in front.
Door Darting:	Teach your pet never to run out the front door when door is open.
Hand Signals:	For all the commands from beside you and at a distance.
Crate/Bed	This is a command to have the dog go and lie down, to a specified choice of word and area.
Correction/ Modification	Correcting or modifying all behavior issues.

Using positive, motivational, respectful techniques, together we can build a relationship that will bring you years of pleasure, happiness and joy to both parties.

By establishing a consistent, fair and fun training plan, a well behaved dog and a harmonious household can be achieved.

Training should start as soon as your dog comes home with you. During the first 4-6 months of life, dogs may develop certain behavior problems which can be avoided with proper early training as we guide your puppy in the right direction. Keep in mind it is never too late to teach your dog good manners.
